With her precious load.

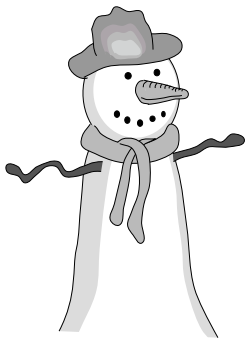
Little donkey, little donkey,

*O come, let us adore Him.....*

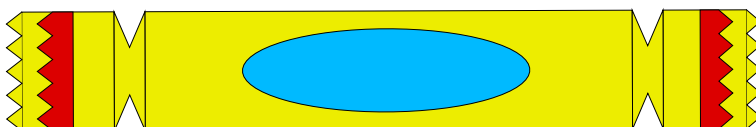
## Once in Royal David's City.

*O tidings of comfort and joy...*

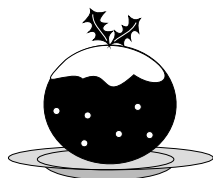
Now to the Lord sing praises,

*O star of wonder, star of night...*

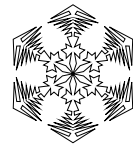


## In the Bleak Mid- Winter.

Which adore.

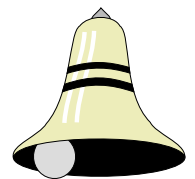
What can I give him
