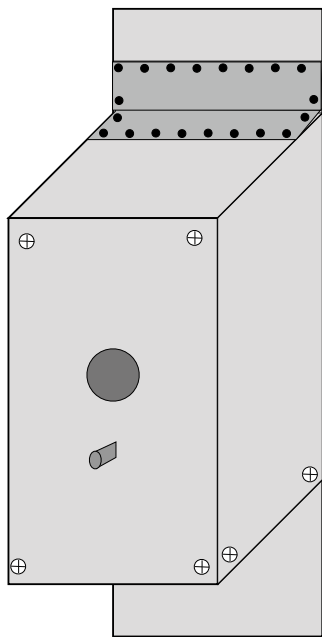


Making a Wooden Nesting Box



You will need :

- A piece of wood 140cms by 15cms by 2 cms deep.
- A piece of dowelling of 4cms long.
- Some kind of safe outside wood protector.
- A piece of felt or flexible plastic / rubber, 15cms by 9cms
- 12 screws and 15 nails.

Equipment needed :

- A 30 cms ruler and pencil
- A saw
- A drill
- A wood bit (to make holes large enough for dowels to fit in and to make a 3 centimetre hole.)
- A hammer and screwdriver.
- Sand paper
- Paint brushes

Instructions :

- 1) Measure up wood as per diagram to side.
- 2) Cut wood along the lines.
- 3) Label each piece.
- 4) Make hole in centre of front piece and place for dowel to sit.
- 5) Sand the edges of each piece, and around the hole on front.
- 6) Screw left hand side to back with 2 screws.
- 7) Screw bottom to left hand side with 2 screws.
- 8) Screw right hand side to both bottom and back, 4 screws.
- 9) Screw front onto right and left side with 4 screws.
- 9) Glue 4cms of felt to top of lid.
- 10) Take felt and nail to top of lid.
- 11) Glue the rest of the felt to the back.
- 12) Nail the felt down on back.
- 13) Put dowel into hole on front.
- 14) Use the wood protector to paint the outside of nest box.
