

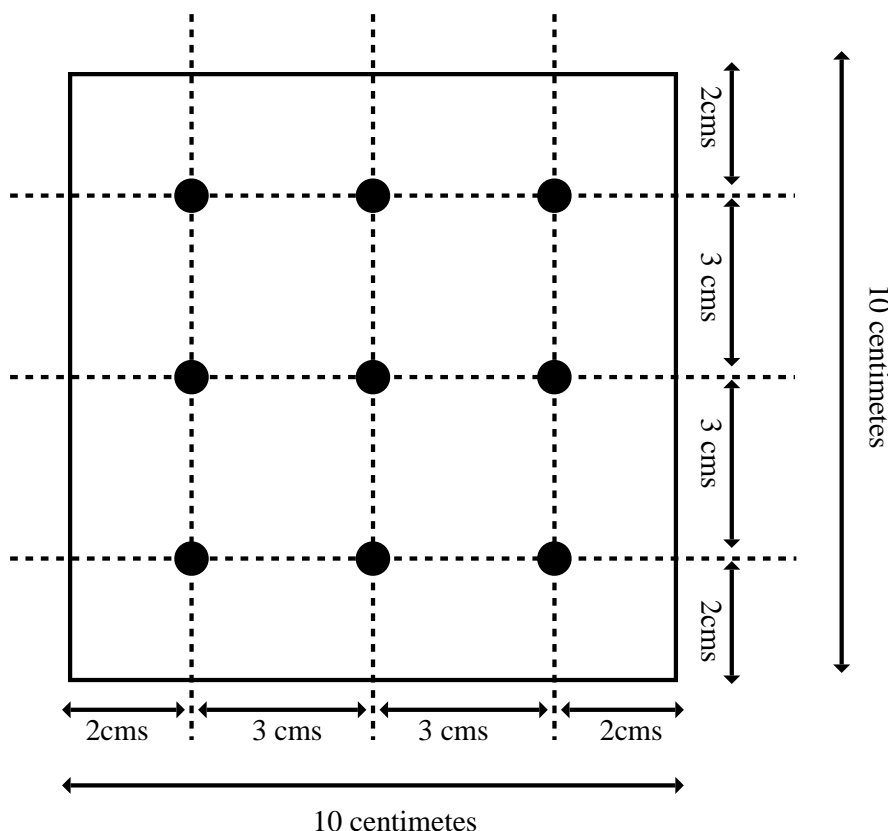
# Making a Wooden Noughts and Crosses Game.

- You will need :
- A piece of wood 10cms by 10cms by 2 cms deep.
  - A piece of dowelling of 20cms long.
  - Some green and blue paints, can be poster.

- Equipment needed :
- A ruler and pencil
  - A saw
  - A drill
  - A wood bit (to make holes large enough for dowels to fit in)
  - A hammer and nail
  - Sand paper
  - Paint brush

## Instructions :

- 1) Measure each side, 2 centimetres, 3 centimetres, 3 centimetres, 2 centimetres, putting a dot at each point.
- 2) Join up each dot, with the dot on the opposite side of the wood.
- 3) At the point where each line crosses, put a cross.
- 4) Use the hammer and nail to put a small hole at each cross.
- 5) Drill at each hole, to a depth of about 1cm.
- 6) Cut the 20 centimetre dowelling into 2 centimetre lengths.
- 7) Paint half of the pieces, blue and the other half, green.
