

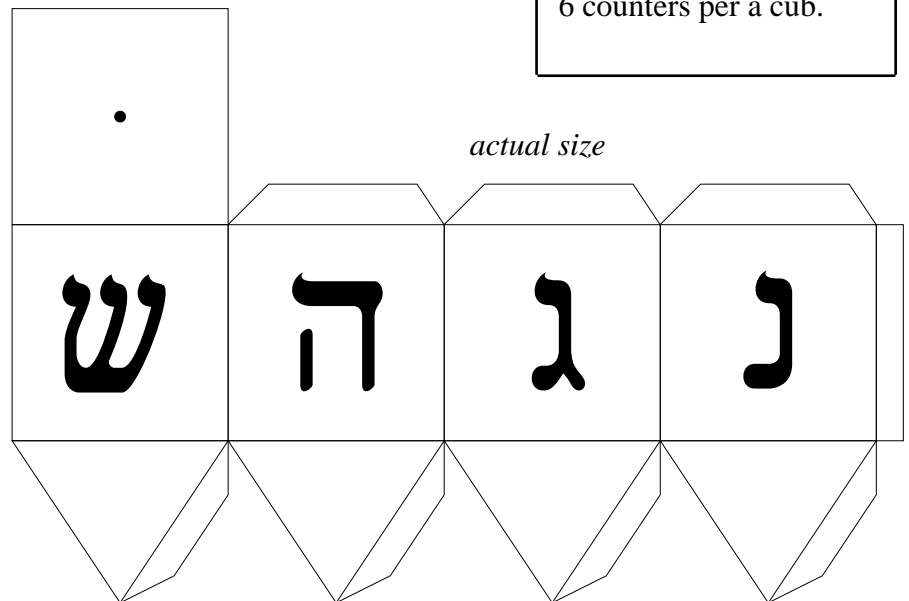
Making and Playing with a Dreidle

Below is the net for a dreidle.

- Stick the net onto a piece of thin card.
- Cut out around the outside of the net
- Fold down all the lines which are left.
- Pierce the dot at the top with a pin.
- Glue all the tabs on the triangles and the one at the side, to make a box with a lid.
- Place some plasticine into the pyramid top.
- Glue the tabs attached to the squares, and press down the side with the hole.
- Push a pencil carefully through the hole into the plasticine at the end.

You will need :

Glue
Scissors
Plasticine
Card
Pencil
Drawing pin
6 counters per a cub.



How to play :

- Every person starts with six counters.
- Take it in turns to spin the dreidle. According to what is facing the top when you stop is then what you have to do.

*If it is a ך then you do **nothing**.*

*If it is a ך then you **get** everything in the middle.*

*If it is a ך then you take **half** of the middle. (Round up for a half.)*

*If it is a ך then you **shell** out a counter into the middle.*

- *The winner is the one with the most counters after playing 15 rounds, or the person who manages to get all the counters.*
