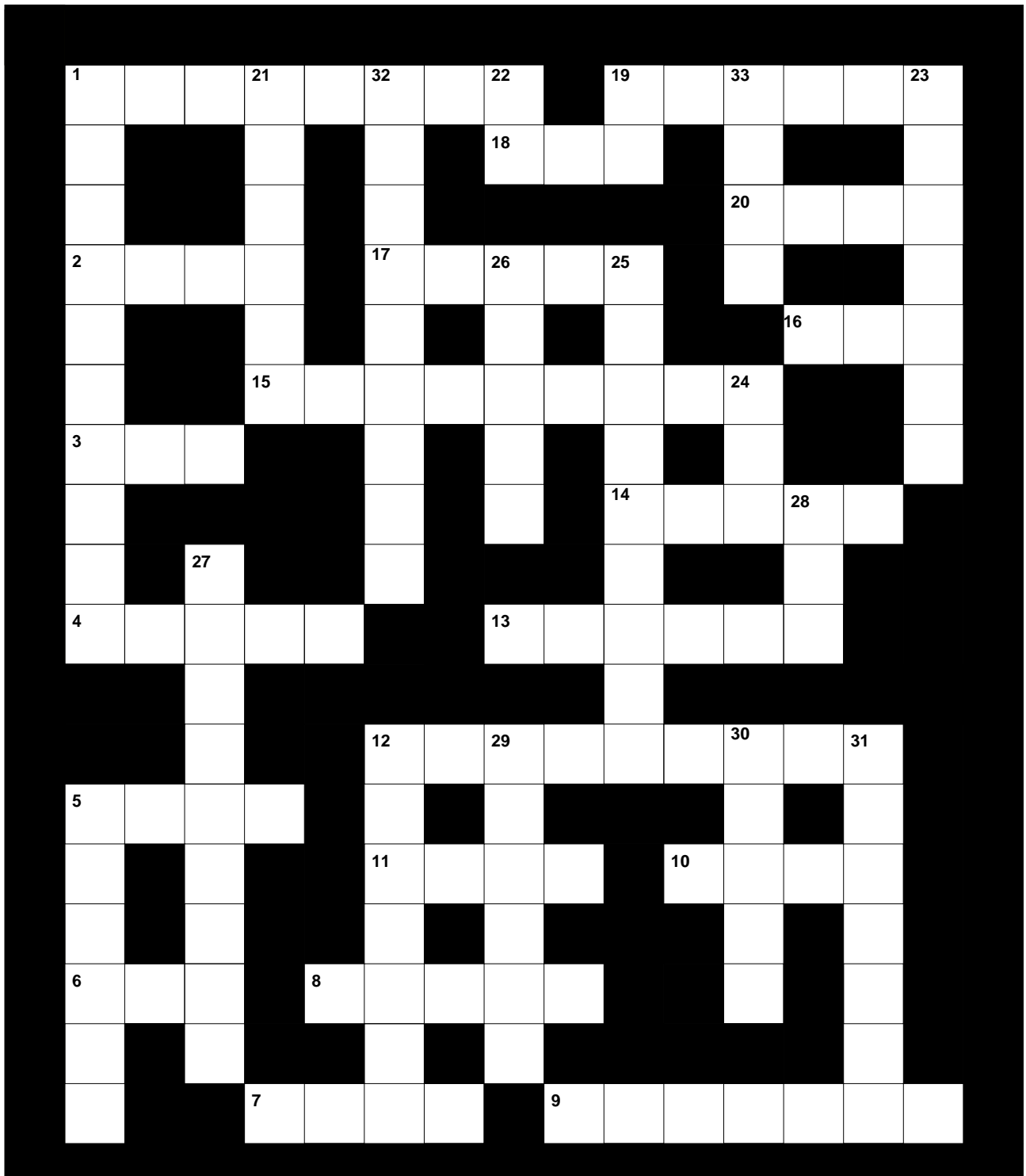
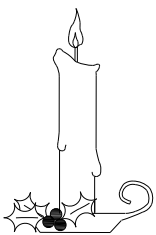


Christmas Crossword

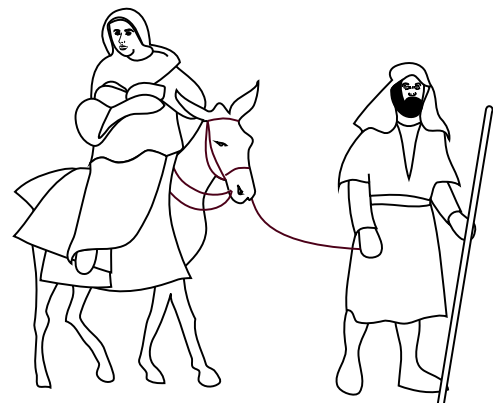
